## **MSCA 2023 Legislative Session Talking Points**

The 2023 legislative session began on January 3. The Minnesota Constitutional deadline for adjournment is May 22.

As members you know, brick and mortar retail has been subjected to unprecedented challenges such as workforce shortages, supply-chain issues, inflation, and changing consumer behavioral that have restricted retail businesses from emerging from the pandemic. During the 2023 legislative session, MSCA will work to encourage legislators to invest in Minnesota's brick and mortar businesses through the following points:

- Reduce and ultimately eliminate the state general levy
- Resolve the Unemployment Insurance deficit without increasing taxes on businesses
- Streamline government regulations by addressing delays in the approval process
- Prohibit increases and additional municipal fees.
